EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Introduction

Public footpaths, bridleways, restricted byways and byways open to all traffic are recorded in Definitive Maps and Statements. These maps and Statements provide conclusive evidence of the existence of public rights of way and are very important to both landowners and users as a record of where the public has a right to walk, ride horses and bicycles and drive vehicles. Clearly, it is in everyone's interest for the Map and Statement to be as accurate and up to date as possible.

The Herefordshire Council ("the Council") is responsible for keeping the Definitive Map and Statement for the County up to date and has a duty under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 to amend them when **evidence** is discovered that they are inaccurate or incomplete. Such amendments are made by means of Modification Orders under Section 53 of the Act.

This Order

The Council has made Modification Orders for the following to changes to the Definitive Map and Statement:

Addition of Bridleway WS4 Westhide, Bridleway YK20 Yarkhill and Bridleway WS5 Westhide

Addition of Bridleway MC46 Much Cowarne, Bridleway OP15 Ocle Pychard, Bridleway YK21 Yarkhill and Bridleway WS6 Westhide

Addition of Restricted Byway MC47 Much Cowarne and Restricted Byway OP16 Ocle Pychard

These Orders simply recognise public rights which the Council believes have already come into existence and records them in the Map and Statement. The Orders do not create any new public rights of way.

If any objections are made and not withdrawn, Herefordshire Council must refer the Order to the Secretary of State, Department of Environment Food and Rural Affairs who will appoint an independent inspector to consider the Order and hear the objections, normally by holding a public local inquiry. Objectors to the Order will be given the opportunity to put forward their case at such an inquiry and will be able to cross examine any witnesses produced by the Council. The Inspector may then decide to confirm the Order, with or without modifications, or may decide that the Order should not be confirmed.

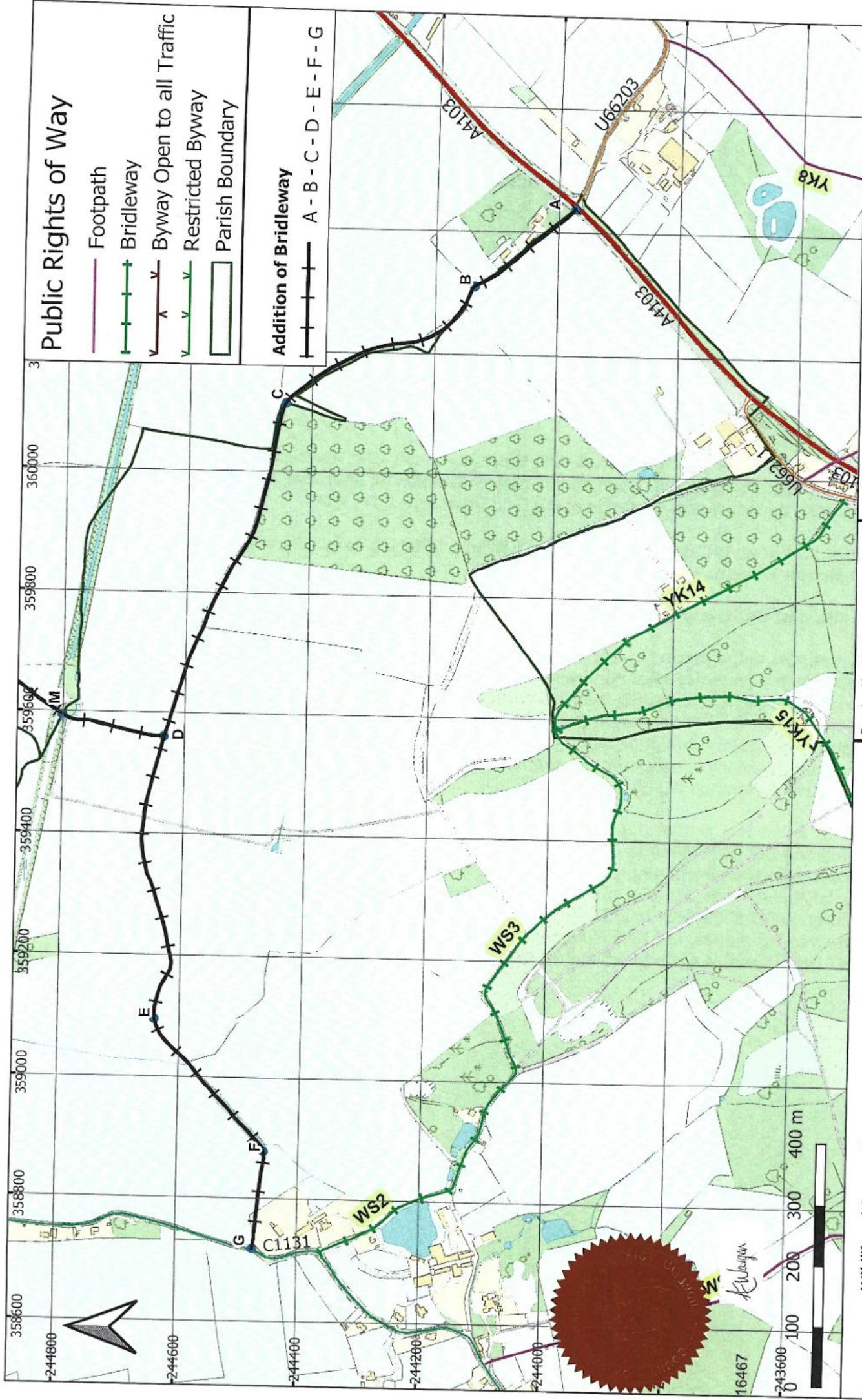

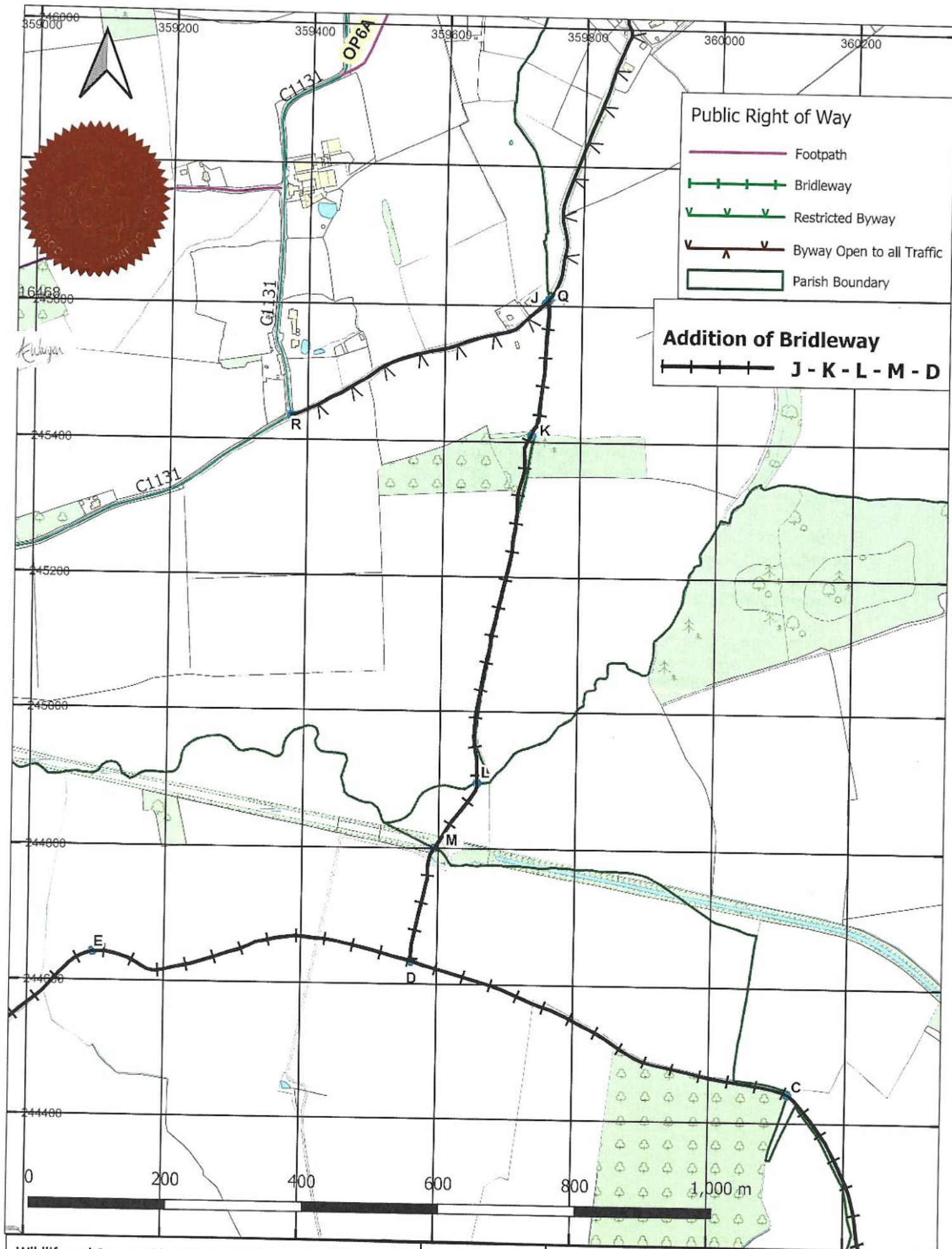
